



At Home Art

Remember to sketch, draw lightly so you can erase.**








Project Uno: (Uno is Spanish for 1. Foreign language class too!?)

Portraits:

<p>The first steps to drawing a portrait.</p>  <p>1. Draw the shape of your head as if it does not have hair. ← (1)</p> <p>2. Half way from the top of the head to the chin draw a line (it is on this line where your eyes will be drawn). Draw this line lightly. (2) →</p> <p>3. Draw a vertical line down the center of the head. This will help keep the features lined up correctly. Draw this line lightly. ← (3)</p> <p>4. Half way from the line for the eyes to the chin draw a short line (this will be the bottom of the nose). Be sure it is lined up with the vertical line (the line going down the center). (4) →</p>	<p>Breaking down each face.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Take your time to shape out the oval, remember to draw lightly, so you can easily erase.2. You can estimate the horizontal line in image 2. You don't have to be exact. As close as you can get is fine.3. Same as step 2, the vertical line in image 3 doesn't have to be perfectly in the middle, estimate as best as you can.4. Image 4 has a small line that is halfway between the horizontal line, and the chin of the face. It represents the bottom of the nose. <p>Note: This is a guideline, all it does is help you separate the face and place all the features in the right space. Eyes, Nose, Ears, Mouth, and Lips.</p>
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Pick a family member, or a friend. You can use this sketch and draw Mom, Dad, Brother or Sister. Just add the specific features they have. Glasses? Mom, earrings? Dad, Beard/Mustache? Brother, Headphones? Sister, Hair Bow?

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

Project Dos: (You guessed it, 2)

This is a refresher, and we have done these before in class.


Below the instructions I'll have a link to a website you can use if you want to make other things.
