

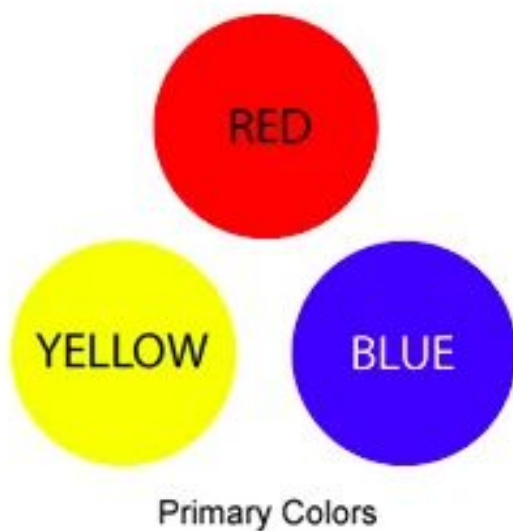

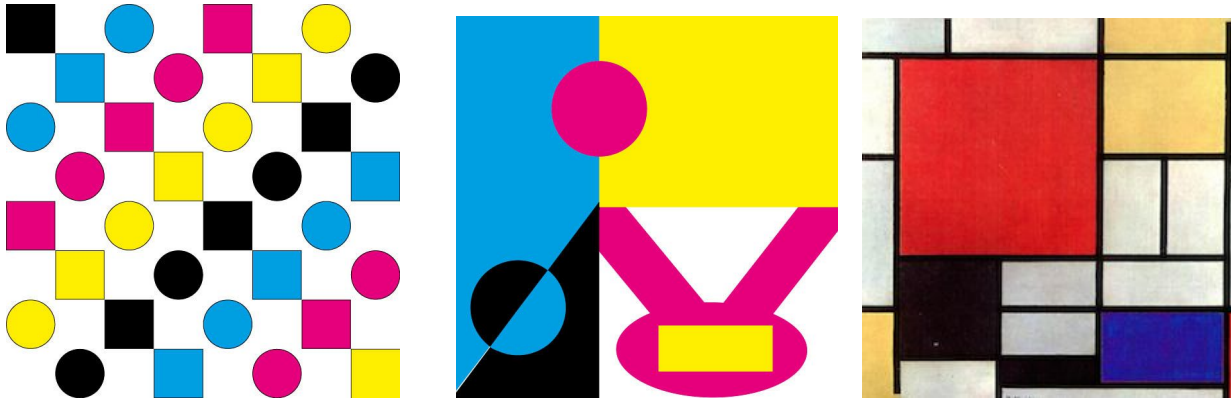
(These are no stress, there will not be a grade. Just some projects if you would like to keep making art. I want all of my students to keep being creative. Stay relaxed and enjoy yourself. See you when school starts back!)

Project 1: Color Identification: Search inside and outside for Primary (Red, Blue, and Yellow) and Secondary (Green, Purple and Orange) Colors. This will help when deciding on colors for your drawings. You will notice that even a tree-trunk is complex with color.

Additional Project: Help with laundry by separating clothing into piles of colors. Do the same thing when folding the laundry.



Project 2: Abstract Art: Trace shapes, create an abstract piece of art by tracing objects you find around your home, or outside. Ex: Food cans (Circles, Various Sizes) Boxes (Rectangles, Cereal, Oatmeal) Ruler, etc. Get creative! :-)



Project 3: Shadow Art: Use your shadow and the sidewalk to make art that explores human shapes. Color the inside the shape, with primary and secondary color.



Project 4: Texture: Take a piece of paper and find textures in surfaces. Sidewalk, bricks, leaves. etc. (Directions: Place paper over surface or object (Leaf) using the side of your pencil rub against the paper. The texture or shape should start to appear on the paper.)



Project 5: Symmetry: Paper Airplanes. A good airplane has even, and precise folds. Take your time. And be prepared to unfold and refold any mistakes. Take them outside and see which flies the farthest or the highest. Or does the most flips (Tricks)
